Dear Akron Children's Hospital Staff,

As COVID-19 continues to surge in our community, the National Guard is joining the Summit County Health Department, the Ohio Department of Health, and our local Akron hospitals to offer a drive-thru COVID-19 testing center in Summit County beginning early next week. The testing center will be located at the Summa Health Corporate Offices located at 1077 Gorge Blvd., Akron, Ohio.

The testing center will be open from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., seven days/week and will provide COVID-19 testing for all ages. The clinic is set to begin on December 27th.

Akron Children's has been asked to help support the community testing center by providing four staff members each day who can serve in non-clinical support roles including duties such as directing traffic and assisting with check-in. Staff do not have to have a clinical background. The National Guard staff will be doing the actual swabbing for the test procedures. Staff will be asked to report for duty from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. to assist with set-up and tear down of the testing center each day

We are seeking volunteers to provide staffing at these clinics on their days off or on weekends. Staff will be paid at the Helping Hands rate of pay for these services. If you are interested in providing these services please contact helpinghands@akronchildrens.org or complete the Interest Form located here on myKidsnet to be enrolled in the program and added to the schedule.

Please note that due to the hospital's current workforce shortages, when assigning staff to work at the testing center preference will be given to non-patient facing and non-clinical staff first. This will ensure that that Akron Children's staff who provide direct care to our patients and families remain available to meet the patient care needs of our patients and families. Assignments will be made on a first-come, first-served basis.

Please note that the testing station is outdoors and will be held rain or shine. Please plan to dress accordingly for the weather.

Due to the short time frame we appreciate your consideration and responses as soon as possible.
